विषय :- राशन कार्ड का आधार सीडिंग एवं सत्यापन का कार्य पूर्ण करने के सम्बन्ध में।

महाशय,

निदेशानुसार उपर्युक्त विषयक भारत सरकार के पत्रांक-9-2/2016-PD.II दिनांक 03.04.2018 एवं विभागीय पत्रांक-2186 दिनांक-08.05.2018 की ओर आपका ध्यान आकृष्ट करते हुए कहना है कि उपरोक्त वर्णित पत्र के आलोक में 30 जून, 2018 तक राष्ट्रीय खाद्य सुरक्षा अधिनियम के अन्तर्गत आच्छादित परिवारों के राशन कार्ड का आधार सीडिंग का कार्य पूर्ण कराने का निदेश दिया गया था। पुनः इस सम्बन्ध में भारत सरकार के पत्रांक-9-2/2016-PD.II दिनांक 14.06.2018 (छायाप्रति संलग्न) के द्वारा कार्य योजना तैयार करते हुए राशन कार्ड/लाभुकों का आधार सीडिंग मिशन मोड में 30 जून, 2018 तक पूर्ण कराने का निदेश दिया गया है।

उल्लेखनीय है कि End to End Computerization के द्वितीय चरण में FPS योजनान्तर्गत सभी लक्षित जन वितरण प्रणाली दुकानों में Rental Basis पर Aadhaar based PoS यंत्रों के अधिष्ठापन की कार्रवाई प्रक्रियाधीन है।

अतः अनुरोध है कि भारत सरकार के उपर्युक्त वर्णित पत्र के आलोक में अविलम्ब कार्य योजना तैयार की जाए एवं जून के अंतिम सप्ताह में विशेष शिविर लगाकर सभी लाभुकों के आधार सीडिंग एवं Bulk Authentication कार्य 30 जून, 2018 तक पूर्ण कराने की कृपा की जाय। साथ ही, इस बात का भी ध्यान रखा जाय कि किसी भी लाभुक को आधार कार्ड के एवज में खाद्यान्न से वंचित नहीं किया जाय।

Subject: Completion of Aadhaar seeding with ration cards – regarding

Sir/Madam.

This is in continuation to this Department's letter of even number dated 3rd April, 2018 requesting States/UTs to prepare a plan of action to complete the seeding of Aadhaar numbers with ration cards/beneficiaries in a mission mode, keeping in view the extended deadline of 30th June, 2018.

2. As per the recent reports available from States/UTs, it is observed that 12 States/UTs have been able to complete the seeding of Aadhaar numbers of at least one member of all the beneficiary household with their ration cards. Another 14 States have been able to complete the same for more than 90% ration cards, but thereafter the progress has been slow. In other States (except Assam and Meghalaya) where significant Aadhaar generation has been achieved, the seeding of Aadhaar numbers with ration cards is much lower and the Aadhaar seeding is not progressing at the desirable rate. A statement showing State/UT-wise Aadhaar seeding with ration cards is annexed.

3. States having less than 90% Aadhaar seeding with ration cards are again requested to prepare a time-bound plan of action with clear timelines for collection and seeding of Aadhaar numbers of remaining beneficiaries/households with their ration cards. For those who are not in possession of Aadhaar, it must be ensured that they are enrolled for Aadhaar or have registered their request for enrolment by giving their name, address, mobile number with ration card number and one of the identification documents specified in proviso (c) of the sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 1 of the Aadhaar notification dated 8th February, 2017, with the fair price shop owners or through the web portal provided for the purpose. For Aadhaar enrolment, enrolment facilities may be provided at convenient locations in collaboration with UIDAI or their designated agencies, and beneficiaries should be guided to approach the nearest such facility. Special camps may also be organised in areas/locations with large number of beneficiaries registered for enrolment.

4. States/UT having achieved more than 90% Aadhaar seeding with ration cards but not able to increase it to 100% may prepare a list of all such beneficiary households whose Aadhaar numbers are yet to be seeded with their ration cards. For those not in possession of Aadhaar, efforts as mentioned in para no. 3 above may be made for generation and seeding of Aadhaar, and for those who are not coming forward to either seed their Aadhaar numbers or submit copy of enrolment ID slips, a special drive may be carried out to physically verify their status and appropriate action may be taken thereafter by the State Government.

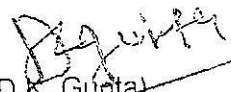
5. States/UTs which have reached 100% Aadhaar seeding in the ration card database but are yet to reach saturation in Aadhaar seeding at the beneficiary level, should ensure completion of Aadhaar seeding at beneficiary level at the earliest. In other States also, where there exists a gap between the Aadhaar seeding at ration card level and at beneficiary level, efforts should be made to ensure that Aadhaar numbers of all beneficiaries in the ration card are seeded, as this would not only result in further cleaning of the beneficiary database but also facilitate authenticated lifting of foodgrains by any member of the household.

6. While taking above efforts for improving Aadhaar enrolment/seeding, it must be ensured that there is no denial of benefits under NFSA due to non-possession of Aadhaar or any other Aadhaar related reasons, as has been clarified vide letter dated 24th October 2017.

7. District-wise progress on above points may be monitored regularly at your level with a view to achieve 100% Aadhaar seeding with ration card by the end of June, 2018.
